



World Academy of Sport Post Graduate Certificate Scholarship Athletes Opportunity - Enrolment - February 2024

Athletes have the opportunity to apply for scholarship opportunities for the World Academy of Sport's (WAoS) <u>Postgraduate Certificate</u>, <u>International Sports Management</u> developed and delivered in conjunction with the University of London.

Scholarship Details

WAoS and the CGF are offering:

- Two (2) full scholarships; and
- Nine (9) x 25% scholarships.

Sales tax will apply for students studying from the following countries: Australia (10%), India (18%), New Zealand (15%) and Singapore (9%).

The value of each 25% scholarship is £1,022. Recipients of a 25% scholarship would be required to self fund the remainder (£3,066 to top it up).

Background

The Post Graduate Certificate (PGCert) programme is a globally-recognised, academically rigorous and industry focused qualification which has been collaboratively developed by the University of London and the World Academy of Sport.

The fully online, self-paced certificate, allows students to complete the course between one and five years.

The 60 credits obtained from the completion of the certificate is a globally recognised qualification that can be further applied to a Master's degree for those students who want to continue their studies to the next level.

The certificate requires that students complete 4 modules – two of which are core and two others from the elective options.

- Core: Strategy, Leadership and Governance in Sport / Financial Management in Sport
- Elective: Sports Marketing, Sponsorship and Media / Sports Event Management / Sports Entrepreneurship / Sport Development, Facilities and Participation

Eligibility

In order to be eligible to receive the scholarship for the Postgraduate Certificate International Sports Management (PG Cert), applicants should:

- Have an existing undergraduate degree (eg bachelor) or a minimum of 5 years of relevant work experience and professional references.
- An English language level of IELTS: at least 6.5 overall, with 6.0 in the written test or other equivalent proficiency certification.
- Access to a computer and internet.

Additional criteria to be considered for final selection:

- Have been an athlete at a previous Commonwealth Games or Commonwealth Youth Games.
- Demonstrate leadership potential as an athlete role model or athlete representative
- Regional representation will be considered.
- An equal representation of gender will be required.

Application Process

- 1. Send out the scholarship details to their athletes
- 2. Eligible candidates can apply directly online, using the online application portal
- 3. Each application will need to be accompanied by a CGA endorsement letter.
- 4. After the online application process is closed, all of the applications will be reviewed by the University of London for eligibility.
- 5. The University of London shortlist will then be reviewed by the CGF Selection Group.
- 6. Both successful and unsuccessful candidates will be contacted regarding the decision.
